

## LICENSE STATUS DEFINITIONS TO APPEAR ON LICENSEE LOOKUP

ACTIVE – License allows Licensee to practice unencumbered under the full scope of the license type, endorsement, or non-disciplinary restriction stated on the license.

ACTIVE PROBATION – License allows Licensee to practice subject to conditions or restrictions set forth in final order addressing disciplinary action.

ACTIVE TEMPORARY – License allows Licensee to practice for a temporary period pending completion of an examination or other condition and may include non-disciplinary restriction stated on the license.

ADMINISTRATIVE SUSPENSION - License suspended due to a technical or administrative violation not connected to the delivery of services or competency of licensee. While violation remains uncured, the administrative suspension status remains in effect and in conjunction with any existing disciplinary action as shown by any documents under the discipline tab. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

CLOSED –License inactivated due to facility or business closure, conversion or discontinuance of license type, or higher level license granted to individual. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

EMERITUS – License recognizes retired status of individual. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

EXPIRED – License not renewed within 45-day grace period. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

EXPIRED PROBATION – Probationary license not renewed within 45-day grace period. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

INACTIVE – License, as requested by Licensee, recognizes Licensee’s voluntary, non-disciplinary, and indefinite cessation of practice. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

INACTIVE EXPIRED – Inactive license not renewed within 45-day grace period. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

INACTIVE PROBATION – License issued or placed on probation after disciplinary action and placed on inactive status. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

INACTIVE RESERVE – License, as requested by Licensee, placed on inactive reserve status while reserve member deployed to active duty. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

INACTIVE SUSPENDED – License suspended after disciplinary action and placed on inactive status. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

RETIRED – License recognizes retired status of individual. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

REVOKED – License revoked due to disciplinary action by board or program. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

SUNSET – Repeal of enabling legislation creating regulation of the profession or occupation. License to practice particular scope of practice at issue no longer required.

SUSPENDED – License suspended due to disciplinary action by board or program. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

SUSPENDED NON-DISCIPLINARY – License suspended by operation of law for nonpayment of child support or student loan default.

SUSPENDED EXPIRED – License otherwise subject to disciplinary suspension not renewed by Licensee and expired. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

TERMINATED – License terminated after two years without renewal. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana** and must reapply to obtain new license.

VOLUNTARY SURRENDER – License voluntarily surrendered by Licensee in lieu of disciplinary action. **Licensee cannot practice in Montana.**

**LICENSE STATUS DEFINITIONS THAT EXIST BUT DO NOT APPEAR ON LICENSEE LOOKUP OR DO NOT REQUIRE DEFINITION**

VOID – License record begun in error, reflects administrative reversal of record.

DECEASED – Individual deceased.
