

Instructions

The Licensee Lookup System allows you to search for information on licensed professionals in Montana. To begin, simply enter the information you would like to search for and click on 'Continue'.

➤Once you are on the search page, there are a variety of ways to search our database:

1. By existing license number;
 - a. License numbers are made up of the three letter acronym for the Board; the acronym for the license type; the letters LIC; and then the license number; each separated by a dash. For example: a guide licensed by the Board of Outfitters will have a license number like this: OUT-GUD-LIC-8546211
2. By board and license type;
3. By first and last name; OR
4. Any combination of the available search fields.

➤Enter the criteria you wish to search by and click 'Search'

➤The Licensee Lookup System will return a list of possible matches to your search criteria. From that list, click on the 'License Number' link for the individual or business you're looking for. This will display the license type, license number, status, expiration date, city, state, and any associated endorsements.

➤To check for any disciplinary action, click on the triangle adjacent to 'Actions' below the Licensee Detail information. This will return any public disciplinary documents for that license OR you will get a message stating "no records found".
