Dear NAB Member Boards and Agencies,

The National Center for Health Statistics is requesting your assistance in sending out the following message to your licensees. Your assistance in supporting this national survey initiative will be great appreciated.

In September, the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) launched its new initiative, the National Study of Long-Term Care Providers (NSLTCP). NSLTCP's purpose is to track trends in the supply and use of five major types of long-term care providers in the U.S.—assisted living and other residential care communities (RCCs), adult day services centers, home health agencies, nursing homes, and hospices. NSLTCP includes a survey of a scientifically selected, random sample of RCCs. Administrators of RCCs are being asked to provide information through a questionnaire. Of the approximately 11,700 RCCs that were asked to participate, about 3,800 RCCs or 32% have responded. NCHS would like to thank those 32% for their participation. We are urging other RCCs that have been invited to participate to respond to the NSLTCP. Every sampled RCC counts and it is not too late to participate! Results are expected to be released late 2013.
