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UNDERSTANDING THE “DECEPTION BY OMISSION” FORM OF SHORT SALE FRAUD

Lenders, insurers, title companies, State Attorneys General, GSE fraud units and the FBI continue to expand their efforts to uncover and prosecute “everyone involved” in deceptive practices and loan fraud, including “Deception by Omission” in short sales.

Therefore, “everyone involved” in a short sale must remember that even though the current Lender is not the Seller or Buyer and not a “client” of the real estate licensee, the current Lender is still deeply involved in, and arguably a party to the transaction. Moreover, the existing Lender is making loan-related financial decisions based on the candor, full disclosure, and basic honesty of the Seller and Buyer, as well as their respective real estate agents.

One of the more frequent forms of loan fraud occurring in short sales today involves the wrong answer to one question: “Do all offers need to be disclosed to the Lender, even when one offer has already been submitted to the Lender for review?” The correct, safe and honest answer is, “Yes.” Frequently, Buyers, Sellers, and Agents and even some ill-informed would-be authorities want to inject false rationales or self-interest based excuses in attempt to make the answer something other than “Yes.”

Perhaps the most basic false premise is the unfortunate fantasy that a short sale is exactly the same as a traditional sale, or to state it more clearly: a sale where the current investors are deprived of much of their money can be handled just like a sale where the investors actually do receive all the money. If the investors’ loss is secretly made worse because they were deceived about the existence of better offers to pay off the loan at a higher price, then they have been defrauded of loan proceeds, and that is loan fraud.

In a traditional sale, the Sellers can instruct their

Agent not to present them any additional offers since, presumably, the Seller would be the “only one deprived” of the additional money from any subsequent better offer. Accordingly, that would typically qualify as a “lawful instruction” of the Seller.

However, in a short sale, the Seller is NOT the only party who will be “deprived” of the additional money. Such a decision to deprive the Lender of the pertinent information and material facts about the short sale, whether by an Agent’s decision or Buyer/Seller instructions, would be considered deception by omission of fact, and therefore not a “lawful instruction.” The Fraud Investigation Unit (FIU) of Freddie Mac defines short sale fraud as, “*Any misrepresentation or deliberate omission of fact that would induce the Lender, investor, or insurer to agree to the terms of a short payoff that it would not approve had all the facts been known.*” In the case of the additional offers, the fraud is in the failure to disclose the offers to the financially affected Lender for their review and response. Remember, in a short sale, it’s their money, their interest, and their decision—period!

As another item of interest, the Montana Board of Realty Regulation recently had a case brought before it in which the Seller and Buyer and their respective Agents failed to advise the short sale Lender about a second, higher offer. BRR does not have jurisdiction over the Seller and Buyer because they are not licensees, but it immediately generated complaints against the two real estate licensees who were involved.

One final note: Virtually no Errors & Omissions (E & O) insurance will protect fraudulent acts or deception by omission, but virtually every lender will hold all parties to be legally and financially responsible for deceptive practices and fraudulent acts.

Relocation in a Global Economy

One of the toughest moments in an experienced broker's life is the moment when a long-time client says "I am sorry Joe. My company has instructed me to list my home with XYZ Realty." (Your biggest competitor) Understanding the WHY of this moment in time can save you time, money, and frustration. It can also show you ways to find opportunity in the global referral market place.

Please understand that I do not personally like how the relocation and referral business has evolved in the past 20 years. However, if you understand it, you can wisely choose your battles—and win.

The best way to describe the relocation third party company is to share with you what was related to me by the head of the Cendant Mobility's negotiation team. He described the way that his company has to compete for this business. All representatives of competing global firms are in one room with a giant screen. They have their laptops loaded with information about the various companies owned by their conglomerate. The corporation flashes on the screen scenarios of their proposed relocations for the next fiscal year. These scenarios include the number of employees transferring, locations considered, services required including purchase and sale of homes, air transportation to find a new home, hotel and rental car costs for that search, moving and packing expenses, carpet and paint to fix up the old home for sale or make the new home ready to occupy, title insurance and escrow fees, mortgage costs, home inspectors, and appraisals. Remember, these conglomerates own businesses that provide all of these services. The conglomerate will have one to two HOURS to offer a total competing bid to provide these services. The glue that holds it all together is the guarantee that the employee will be required by contract with his/her employer to use the companies owned by the conglomerate. A big part of that glue is the referral fee paid by the listing and selling agents for the ability to provide services for

those referred clients. The contract between the corporation and the conglomerate has some strict penalty clauses that apply when an employee is allowed to buck the system and try to negotiate his own deals.

It is not all that great on the side of the broker who provides the services. The required referral fee is 25% to 35% of the total commission of the home sold or purchased. The commission is set by the conglomerate. All agents approved to receive these referrals must complete relocation training and do volumes of paperwork. In order to qualify for this business, the broker must have a relocation director who is NOT paid on commission. During the years that I worked as relocation director, I learned the why of all of these requirements. When US Customs moved 75 agents into the Highline area of Montana, there were no relocation trained agents for any firm in that area. I reached an agreement to place the business providing that I do all the necessary paperwork to back up the agent. This is one of the few times that I was able to go outside the system.

So--- to try and convince your longtime customer and/or his company that you can do the job as well as, or better, the competing firm is a waste of time. Ethics complaints and complaints to the Board of Realty Regulation will go nowhere. If you get really aggressive about it, you will be told that you run the risk of being charged with contractual interference. It will totally bum you out!

What to do?? First, ALWAYS ask your client if there is the possibility of receiving relocation benefits. This is true even if they do not yet work for the company. I encountered this with medical personnel transferring into Billings. It has not always occurred to the person that there may be benefits. When they inquire they will be informed of requirements regarding the sale and purchase of a home. It keeps you from doing a lot of work and then finding out that you will not get paid.

There are some possibilities that you can try IF you have been in the business more than five years, have a broker's license, understand and actively use agency agreements, always use home inspections and warranties, and are willing to use the lenders, title companies and appraisers required. You will almost NEVER get the listing. I have seen one exception in 40 years in the business. You may be able to negotiate for the next buyer coming into the area. Buyers do not require as much paperwork and corporations do like to have 2 or 3 competing small brokerage firms to handle occasional referral business. It is a way of keeping their network brokerage firms from inflating fees and costs. They do require complete familiarity with all of the services outlined above. This information was shared with me about 15 years ago by the Human Resources Director of a major oil company. Using this information, I was able to get on the approved list for several of the third party conglomerates. It can result in 3 or 4 clients a year.

Finally, if you are successful in negotiating some of this business for yourself, there is a way to guarantee that you continue to get it. Ask for a copy of the itemized list of the employee's relocation benefits. You want the list, not the agreement. This will tell you how to structure transactions to maximize benefits for your client or his company. Companies may pay discount points, but not fees. They may pay mortgage broker costs but not commissions. Some require that the seller pay certain costs, some require the buyer to pay certain costs. By negotiation, you can see that your client is not requiring the other party to pay costs that his company will pay. On the other hand, if your client is trying to impress his boss, he may want to have the other party pay those costs so he can demonstrate that he is saving his company money. When you do this, be sure and point it out in your closing letter thanking the corporation for the opportunity for the business.

Fannie Mae Launches Unique Video to Help Distressed Homeowners

In the face of still-growing numbers of failed or at-risk U.S. residential mortgages, state and federal governments, industry stakeholders, consumer groups and counseling organizations have launched countless legislative, policy and outreach initiatives that are designed to provide relief from, alternatives to, or consumer information about foreclosures. One of the newest consumer resources comes from government-sponsored enterprise (GSE) Fannie Mae, which has created a unique interactive video tool that allows struggling homeowners to "play out" the often confusing options that arise when hard decisions about continued homeownership must be made.

Fannie Mae's new cost-free video is called WaysHome™ and allows users to experience scenarios that address options for avoiding foreclosure including repayments plans, forbearances, modifications, deeds-in-lieu, short sales and other alternatives. The WaysHome™ video is set in a fictional U.S. neighborhood that has been hurt by the foreclosure crisis. Actors play three homeowners in the neighborhood, each of whom is in a different stage of financial distress.

What makes the video unique is its interactivity. Users select one of the homeowners whose circumstances are most similar to their own. Successive "movie" segments present various decisions that face the selected homeowner. The user selects from among the decision choices and a new video segment "plays out" the consequences, both positive and negative, of that choice. For example, in the scenario involving a delinquent mortgagor, one of the early choices is to simply ignore the telephone calls being received from mortgage servicers and collection agencies. The video demonstrates the less-than-optimal results of that choice and a narrator suggests that the user go back and select the "answer the phone" option. This leads to a simulation of what the callers will say, why and what will happen next. Regardless of the initial scenario that is selected, WaysHome™ users are also presented with information about various available government-sponsored and other foreclosure alternatives, and their consequences.

The WaysHome™ video simulation is accessible through the GSE's homeowner outreach website, <http://www.KnowYourOptions.com>. The website provides numerous tools for struggling homeowners such as interactive options finders, calculators and other informational videos. Fannie Mae's website says that the GSE "...welcomes links to its Internet sites...". However, certain conditions apply and should be consulted through the "Legal" link at the bottom of the web site's home page.

NEW! CORE COURSE REQUIREMENT

Beginning with the 2012 license year (November 1, 2011-October 31, 2012), the Board of Realty Regulation will be implementing a requirement that all active Montana real estate licensees take a required core course *in addition to* the currently required 12 hours of continuing education. For the 2012 licensing year, the core course will be 4 hours long; however this may change from year to year depending on the depth and breadth of information the Board would like to see covered. This means that for the 2012 license year, all licensees will be required to take 16 total hours of education—one 4 hour core course and 12 hours additional continuing education (with at least 4 hours of the 12 from a mandatory topic).

The purpose of the core course(s) is to provide licensees with legal and legislative updates and to cover current updates on topics that affect the practice of real estate in Montana.

One core course is being developed for brokers/salespeople, and another is being developed specifically for property managers. Licensees should take the core course that best aligns with the focus of their daily practice.

WARNING: CRAIGSLIST RENTAL FRAUD

The Board of Realty Regulation would like all licensees, but especially those doing property management, to be aware of Craigslist rental scams currently being used in Montana.

Basically, someone will use content from a legitimate advertisement (either online or in a newspaper) to place a false rental advertisement for a property on Craigslist. The customer may drive by to look at the apartment or house and see a “For Rent” sign in the window, but when they mail in their first month’s rent and security deposit, they discover they have given money to someone (usually overseas) who has no right to rent the property.

The average consumer often has no idea that such items are a scam, and the more properties that are “rented” under these circumstances, the less faith the public has in real estate licensees in general. For those of you currently managing property in Montana, I would encourage you to periodically check the online Craigslist rentals in your area and make sure that none of the properties you manage are falsely listed. Should you find any suspect listings, contact your local law enforcement to report the fraud.

CYBER ETHICS

The explosion of social networking and the ubiquitous sharing and posting of so much information online have changed the way we communicate. We must ensure that users understand their responsibilities for conducting themselves online. An important component of that is Cyber Ethics. Cyber Ethics refers to the code of responsible behavior on the Internet. We should all employ the basic tenets of Cyber Ethics to be good "cyber citizens."

Who Should Be Concerned About Cyber Ethics?

Cyber ethics must be taught and reinforced at every level of computer use—from the novice user just learning to navigate a computer and the Internet, to an information professional whose job requires significant use of online resources. In the same way that each culture teaches its citizens the ethics of business, education, government, etc., those who use the Internet must be taught ethical practices in every aspect of its use.

Why Should We Be Concerned About Cyber Ethics?

The power of the Internet means that anyone can communicate at anytime, with anyone, anywhere. While this has undeniable benefits, there can also be negative consequences. Anonymous posting to blogs, websites and social media can encourage bad behavior by eliminating the need to stand behind the words used.

A significant issue of increasing concern is cyber bullying. What were once comments confined to the school yard or hallways are now magnified by the power and anonymity of the Internet. Developments in electronic media offer new forums for bullies, and the actions can range in severity from cruel or embarrassing rumors to threats, harassment, or stalking. The effects can be far-reaching and long lasting.

What Are The Rules Of Ethical Cyber Activity?

The basic rule is do not do something in cyber

space that you would consider wrong or illegal in everyday life.

When determining responsible behaviors, consider the following:

- Do not use rude or offensive language. Don't be a bully on the Internet. Do not call people names, lie about them, send embarrassing pictures of them, or do anything else to try to hurt them.
- Do not copy information from the Internet and claim it as yours. Adhere to copyright restrictions when downloading material, including software, games, movies, or music from the Internet.
- Do not break into someone else's computer.
- Do not use someone else's password.
- Do not attempt to infect or in any way try to make someone else's computer unusable.

We were taught the rules of "right and wrong" growing up. We just need to apply the same rules to cyber space!

DO I NEED TO PROVIDE A SEPARATE DISCLOSURE FORM FROM THAT WHICH IS CONTAINED IN THE BUY SELL AGREEMENT?

The Board of Realty Regulation's office has received numerous questions from licensees regarding the "Real Estate Agent's Required Documents" form that was recently mailed to all Brokers. The most common question has been, "Do I need a separate disclosure than what is contained in the Buy Sell Agreement?" Those licensees asking that question have one thing in common: they are members of the Montana Association of Realtors®, and therefore, can legally refer to themselves as a Realtor®. One of the benefits of being a member of the Montana Association of Realtors® (MAR®) is the access to Real Estate Forms including the Buy Sell Agreement. **Licensees need to remember that not all licensed real estate agents (salespeople or brokers) are Realtors®.** In order to practice real estate activity, you **must** have a license issued by the Board of Realty Regulation which is a State of Montana Agency and is not affiliated with MAR®. Real Estate Licensees **DO NOT** have to be a member of the Montana Association of Realtors® referred to as a Realtor® to practice real estate activity. Therefore, the list of required documents is set up for all licensees **REGARDLESS** of whether or not he/she is a Realtor®.

The list of "Real Estate Agent's Required Documents" form is found on the Board of Realty Regulation's website at www.realestate.mt.gov under the "Trust Acct" tab. Next to each required form is a live link to the specific law and/or rule. For those questions you have regarding the required disclosure, you will want to review the law and/or rule to determine if the Buy Sell Agreement you use contains the required disclosure.

SUPERVISING BROKERS: POTENTIAL COMPLAINTS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION

As a Supervising Broker, you should be aware of the fact that your responsibilities as a supervisor include far more than simply reviewing the files for the salespeople under you. Basically, anything a salesperson under you does (or does not do) could potentially result in a complaint *also* being filed against you, the supervising broker, for failure to supervise.

The following are just a few examples of instances where disciplinary action against a salesperson could result in disciplinary action against the supervising broker:

- A salesperson fails to renew his/her license in a timely manner and is performing real estate duties with an expired license.
- A salesperson renews his/her license but fails to complete the required annual continuing education.
- A salesperson renews his/her license but fails to report legal or disciplinary action instituted against them.

As you can see, it is always best to have office practices and procedures which allow you to monitor those salespersons under your supervision.

Jeanne Rizzotto #2009-027-RRE

On October 6, 2008, a complaint was filed against Jeanne Rizzotto (broker license #9009) alleging that she had failed to properly supervise a salesperson. The complaint alleged that the salesperson, who was their buyer's agent, failed to disclose that the property they purchased was located in an area that frequently flooded. The evidence before the Screening Panel indicated that the salesperson knew that the buyers were unfamiliar with the area in which the property was located and were concerned about potential problems in the area. Pursuant to the rules governing supervision of salespersons by their brokers, Ms. Rizzotto should have been reviewing her salesperson's transactions. At that time, Ms. Rizzotto should have informed her salesperson about the well-known flooding problems in the area, since Ms. Rizzotto had an established practice in the Red Lodge area for many years. The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Ms. Rizzotto violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered the Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Ms. Rizzotto.

Ms. Rizzotto entered into a Stipulation with the department counsel in which she neither admitted nor denied the contentions. Pursuant to the Board's Final Order, Ms. Rizzotto must complete eight hours of supervising broker endorsement class within one year from the date of the Final Order. The education will not count as part of her annually required continuing education.

Kerrie Rochon #2009-063-RRE

On December 23, 2008, a complaint was filed against Kerrie Rochon (salesperson license # 9044). The complaint rose out of a failed personal business partnership between Ms. Rochon and two other people. The intent of the partnership was to purchase a commercial property together. The complainant is one of those business partners. He alleged that Ms. Rochon had failed to comply with regarding the purchase and ownership of

commercial property in Red Lodge, Montana. Specifically, the two other buyers contributed financing to, exerted control over, and shared in the profits and losses of said commercial property. However, Ms. Rochon had drawn up the papers with the result that she was listed as the majority shareholder of the LLC which purchased the property, even though all the funding came from the other two partners. The two partners filed suit against Ms. Rochon. On May 27, 2008, the District court ruled against Ms. Rochon. The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Ms. Rochon violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that the Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Ms. Rochon.

Ms. Rochon entered into a stipulation with Department Counsel in which she admitted the Department's contentions. Pursuant to the Board's Final Order, Ms. Rochon's license will be placed on probation for a period of one year from the date of the Final Order.

Ms. Rochon must complete, at her own expense, an additional four hours of continuing education in the subject of agency and an additional four hours in the subject of ethics. The courses must be approved by the Board of Realty Regulation for the purposes of continuing education. The courses shall be taken in addition to the regularly required continuing education, and must be obtained within one year of the Final Order.

Karl Sorenson #2010-039-RRE

On October 19, 2009, the Screening Panel of the Board of Realty Regulation received a complaint against Karl Sorenson (broker license # 3789) from a tenant alleging that Mr. Sorenson had violated the Landlord/Tenant Act. The screening panel found reasonable cause to believe Mr. Sorenson violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Mr. Sorenson. Mr. Sorenson entered into a stipulation with Department Counsel in which he admitted the Department's contentions.

Mr. Sorenson's license will be placed on probation for one year beginning on the date of the Final Order. Additionally, within three months, he must successfully complete a continuing education course, "Trust Accounting for Property Management" given by Board Auditor Marilyn Willson. This course is in addition to the regularly required continuing education.

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Scott Pitman #2009-025-RRE

On September 18, 2008, a complaint was filed against Scott Pitman (broker license #11770) alleging that Mr. Pitman cashed earnest money checks without the complainant's knowledge or consent. The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Mr. Pitman violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Mr. Pitman.

Mr. Pitman entered into a stipulation with Department Counsel in which he denies some contentions in the Department's Notice. However, he did agree that settlement is in the best interest of all parties involved.

Within 30 days of issuance of the Final Order, Mr. Pitman will voluntarily surrender his broker license to the Board of Realty Regulation. Mr. Pitman may not renew/reinstate his license or apply for a new license sooner than one year from the date of the Final Order, and when he does apply for a new Montana license after one year, he shall be required to present proof of a settlement agreement between him and the complainant.

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Cheryl Shepp #2011-024-RRE

Following an audit by the Board of Realty Regulation, a complaint was filed against Cheryl Shepp (broker license #12364) alleging the following:

- acting as a buyer's agent without having written buyer/broker agreements,
- not having a running balance after each entry in the check register,

- failing to properly maintain a transaction register,
- and failing to keep a personal funds ledger.

The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Ms. Shepp violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that Department Counsel file disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Ms. Shepp.

Ms. Shepp entered into a stipulation with Department Counsel in which she admitted the Department's contentions. Ms. Shepp's license is placed on probation for a period of one year from the date of the Final Order.

Within 60 days of the date of the Final Order in this matter, Ms. Shepp must pay an administrative fine of \$350.00. At her own expense, Ms. Shepp must successfully complete a continuing education course, "Trust Accounting for Property Management." Ms. Shepp must register for the course with the Board's auditor within ten days of the Final Order.

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James McLeod #2011-028-RRE

On August 26, 2010, the Screening Panel of the Board of Realty Regulation filed a complaint against James McLeod (broker license #6762) alleging that Mr. McLeod failed to properly supervise a salesperson under his supervision. Mr. McLeod was unaware that the salesperson who he supervises had failed to renew her real estate license. The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Mr. McLeod violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that the Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Mr. McLeod.

Mr. McLeod entered into a stipulation with Department Counsel in which he admitted the Department's contentions. Within 30 days of the date of the Final Order, Mr. McLeod must pay an administrative fine of \$150.00. Further, Mr. McLeod is publicly censured for the violations note in the Notice of Proposed Board Action.

On April 20, 2009, a Notice of Proposed Board Action and Opportunity had been issued to Sandra Torgerson-Gould (salesperson license # 12665). Ms. Torgerson did not appear or contest. On July 16, 2010, a Final Order of Default was entered against Ms. Torgerson-Gould. The Default Final Order required Ms. Torgerson-Gould to pay an administrative fine of \$200.00. The licensee failed to respond or pay the fine. Subsequently, a second complaint was filed against Ms. Torgerson-Gould alleging failure to comply with a Final Order of the Board. The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Ms. Torgerson-Gould violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Ms. Torgerson.

On December 6, 2010, Ms. Torgerson-Gould was duly served with a Notice of Proposed Board Action regarding the second complaint (for failure to comply with the Board's previous Final Order). Again, Ms. Torgerson failed to respond. The Department requested Entry of Default on January 6, 2011. The default was entered and the Board ordered that Ms. Torgerson's license is revoked.

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Alton Bazinet #2010-108-RRE

On June 7, 2010, a complaint was filed against Alton Bazinet (salesperson license # 13107) alleging the following:

- Mr. Bazinet had been hired as a listing agent to sell a property in Lincoln. The sellers were in danger of foreclosure. Mr. Bazinet offered to rent the property himself while he was trying to sell it. He signed a rental agreement and paid rent on the property for three months. Thereafter, Mr. Bazinet failed to make rent payments.
- Mr. Bazinet told the owner that once the bank stated that the house was going to a trustee's sale, the sellers no longer owned the property and he (Bazinet) no longer had to pay them rent. Mr. Bazinet told the complainant/owner that he thought

he (Bazinet) could purchase the home through a short sale.

- In February 2010, Mr. Bazinet sent the sellers a commission agreement on the house he was selling and purchasing and for which he had failed to pay rent since June 2009. During this time, licensee placed his salesperson license on inactive status while he was still representing the sellers as their seller's agent. He believed no license was necessary because this was a personal transaction.

The screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Mr. Bazinet violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules and ordered that Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Mr. Bazinet.

On December 17, 2010, Mr. Bazinet was served with a Notice of Proposed Board Action. Mr. Bazinet did not appear or contest. The Department requested Entry of Default on January 13, 2011, and a Final Order of Default was entered. The Default Final Order required Mr. Bazinet to pay an administrative fine of \$100.00 and successfully complete 4 hours of continuing education in ethics within three months of the date of the Final Order.

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Christopher "Max" Detjens #2011-035-RRE

On July 19, 2010, a complaint was filed against Christopher Detjens (property management license # 706) alleging that Mr. Detjens failed to return a tenant's security deposit according proper procedures. Upon entering the apartment he had rented from Mr. Detjens' property management company, the tenant found that the heat was not working properly. Because the tenant had not occupied or moved any belongings into the apartment, he wrote a letter asking the he be refunded the total amount for his rent and security deposit. Mr. Detjens withheld funds from the security deposit to cover the property management company's leasing fee. The (con't on page 12)

screening panel of the Board of Realty Regulation found reasonable cause to believe Mr. Detjens violated Board statutes and/or administrative rules, and ordered that Department Counsel file a disciplinary Notice of Proposed Board Action against Mr. Detjens.

On December 23, 2010, Mr. Detjens was served a Notice of Proposed Board Action. Mr. Detjens

did not appear or contest. The Department requested Entry of Default on January 18, 2011. The Board ordered Mr. Detjens to successfully complete a continuing education course, "Trust Accounting for Property Management." This course is in addition to required continuing education. Within ten days of the date of the Final Order, Mr. Detjens must contact Board Auditor Marilyn Willson to register for the course.
